Rules of Fair Chase

Any animal taken under any of the following circumstances **shall not be considered** taken under the Rules of Fair Chase:

1. Helpless in or because of deep snow
2. Helpless in water
3. Helpless on ice
4. Helpless in a trap
5. While confined behind inescapable fences, such as game farms, etc.
6. In defiance or violation of game laws or out of season
7. By "Jack Lighting" or shining at night
8. From any powered vehicle or powered boat
9. Any other method considered unsportsmanlike by NDBA, NFAA, or the Pope & Young Club.
